

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

## 1. How does the University of Pennsylvania make admissions decisions?

All applications are reviewed by committees of multiple admissions officers. The evaluation process is thorough and considers all required materials, both academic and non-academic.

2. Can I appeal my decision?

No. After careful deliberation, all decisions are final, and there is no appeals process.

## 3. If I decide to take a gap year, may I reapply next year?

Yes, you may reapply to the University of Pennsylvania for the next academic year. Taking a gap year should not be an admission strategy and should only be taken for educational and growth opportunities.

## 4. Does the University of Pennsylvania accept transfer students? Yes, the University of Pennsylvania welcomes transfer applications for fall
