

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How does the University of Pennsylvania make admissions decisions? All applications are reviewed by committees of multiple admissions officers. The

evaluation process is thorough, considering all required materials, both academic and non-academic.

2. Can I appeal my decision?

No. After careful deliberation, all decisions are final, and there is no appeals process.

3. How many transfer applicants were admitted?

This year we received over 2,600 transfer applications and offered admission to around 200 students.
